Social Service program: We gave out food bags to slum areas, nuns, and others who were in need. As part of our support, we also provided regular assistance to 10 victims of Covid 19.

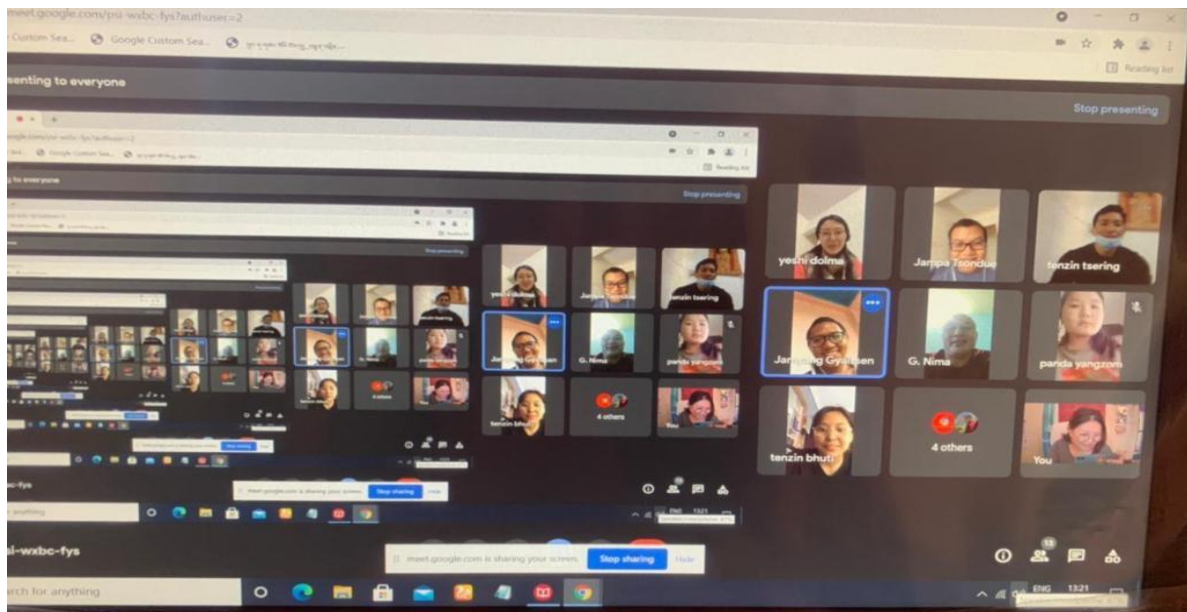
Donated: 60 Books, many furniture and stationery.

In spite of the fact that we couldn't hold the same event as we did before the pandemic, we still felt that we were able to celebrate all the programs we have run for people this year.

Educational Program

We provided international classes online; English Online Class, French Online Class, and Chinese Online Class. It was challenging to find teachers who could educate students online, but we were fortunate enough to find dedicated teachers and students who were keen to learn. We had over 100 students who joined our programs in 2021.



a) January 2021

We completed an online international language program on 20th Jan 2021. It was the first time for us to organize online classes

b) May 2021

From 17th May 2021 to 16th July 2021, Tibet World started a new online Chinese course for two months. We offered a one-hour beginners' level course at 8:30 am, and an elementary level course from 9:30 am- 10:30 am.

c) July 2021

On 25th July 2021, we completed our second language course.

d) August 2021

We organized an Online Chinese Language course from 2nd August to 1st October 2021. The course was available in three levels: Elementary, Beginner, and Intermediate.

e) September 2021

From 1st September to 29th October 2021, Tibet World organized an online French Course, (elementary level). Its main objective was to focus on delivering knowledge about practical communication.

Cultural program

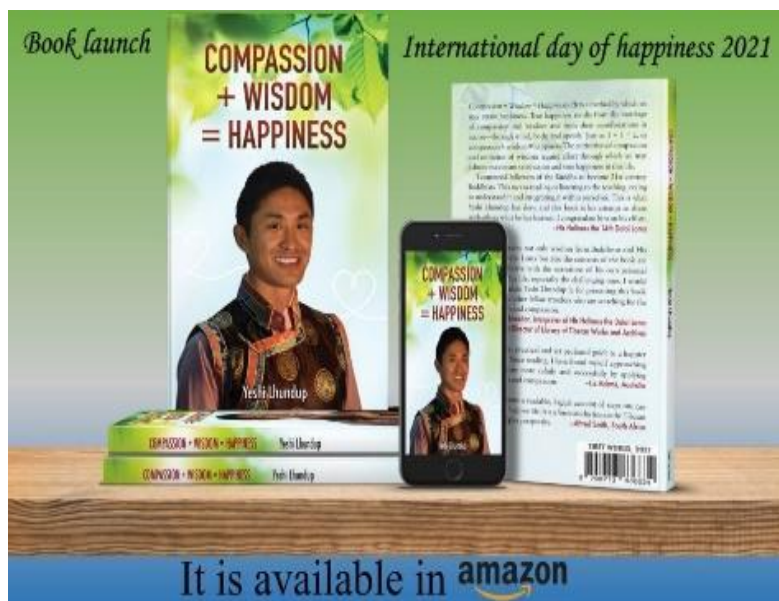

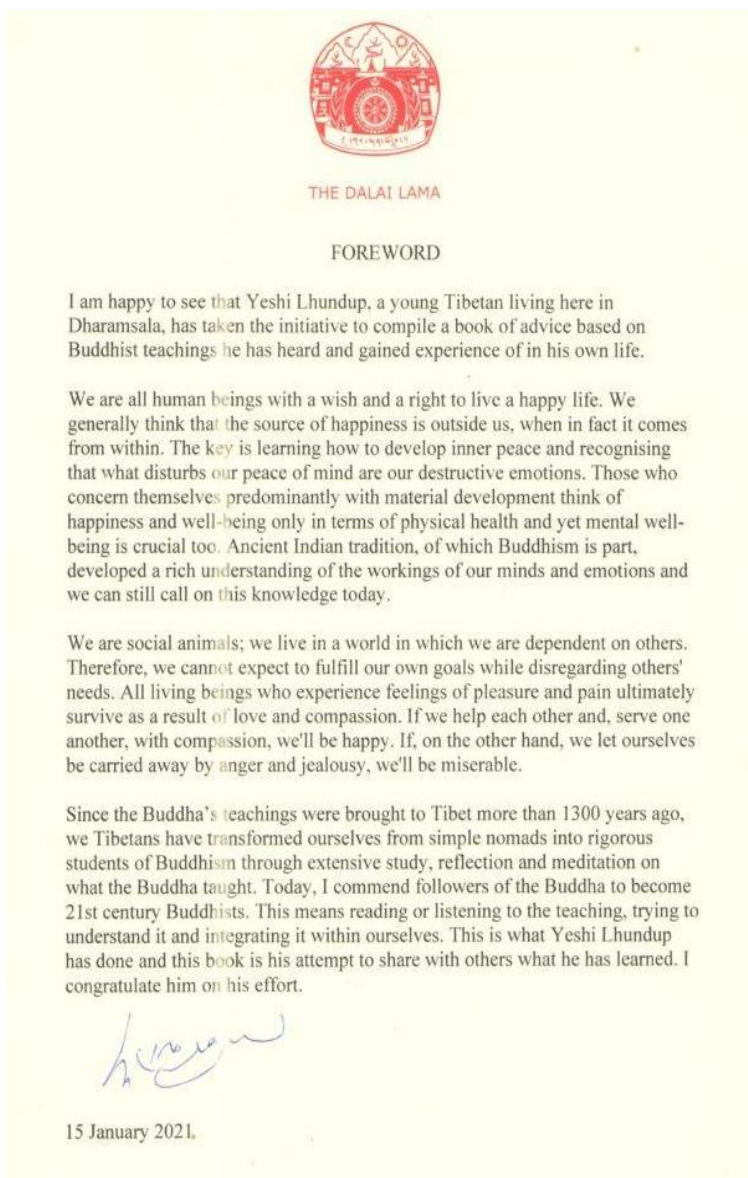

We were not able to hold on to our library, hostel, community hall, and classrooms because the rent was so expensive, but we had a small office and were able to offer good social services with your very kind support. Temporarily our Tibet World offers online classes, and cultural events but hostels are closed.

Due to this world pandemic, there has been huge physical and emotional damage to the whole world. We hope that everyone is staying healthy and safe.

5. We donated 4 bags of clothes to the local Slum.
6. We sold our cushions and other things at a very minimum price for an old age home.

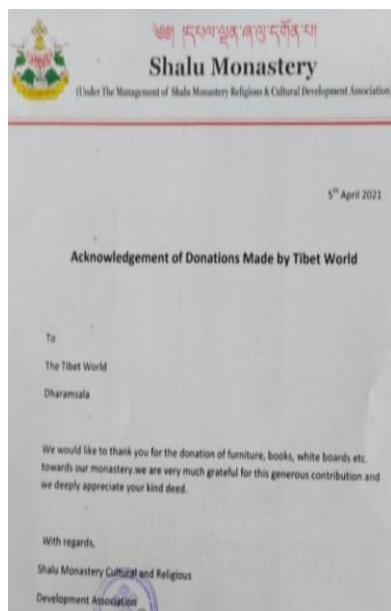
